Planning Meeting 17.09.14 - Our grant of £7000 has been approved by Locality on behalf of the Department of Communities & Local Government - 2 people from the Urban Planning studies department of the London School of Economics are visiting Mill Hill 31.7.14 to discuss a study to be performed by Masters Students in Mar-Jun2015. There will not a charge for this but we will have to confirm their brief based on our perceived priorities and guide the students through the exercise. - Chair is discussing an offer from Towns Alive to do a study of our Town Centre/Retail offering - The Sale Particulars for the NIMR site on the Ridgeway have been published by Deloitte - The proposal to deposit, from landfill 28,100 Cubic Metres of soil at St Vincents School to level a playing field were discussed. This would have a detrimental effect on Wildlife and notably the residents of Woodcote Avenue - We discussed our Website and agreed to additionally get the Domain www.millhill.london

Mill Hill Broadway Station

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Discussion	As Mill Hill Broadway Station is such an unsightly “bookend” to Mill Hill Broadway, work that we encourage to improve the “look & feel” of the Broadway will have little or no impact unless the issues with Mill Hill Broadway Station are addressed. (Comment endorsed post meeting by LSE Visitors on Tour of Mill Hill 31/7)

Conclusions	It was noted that Sound Proofing & Solar panels need to be incorporated in the design to reduce current levels of noise & air pollution and to generate cheap electricity in the process. Further it was noted that many buses only pass through on their routes and should not need to enter a bus depot. The old railway line between Mill Hill East & Mill Hill Broadway could be used by a “Lite” rail or tram solution to improve public transport between Mill Hill East & Mill Hill Broadway.
